

Here are the instructions to germinate your seeds.

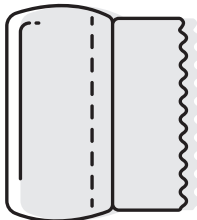
What you'll need:



Cannabis seeds



2 saucers or plates



paper towel



spray bottle filled with bottled or potable tap water

Take your time

Your seeds will likely germinate within 3 days, but remember they can take upwards of a full week to sprout.

Germinating seeds cannot be allowed to dry out.

6 Simple steps

1. Line a saucer with a layer of damp paper towel and drain any excess water from the saucer. Place your seeds on the layer of paper towel. If you're germinating more than 1 seed at a time, space them 6.5 cm (2.5 inches) apart.
2. Cover your seeds with another layer of damp paper towel.
3. Cover with the second saucer and move to a warm area (approximately 21°C), away from direct light.
4. Check the status of your seeds every 6–12 hours to ensure they aren't drying out. If needed, spray the paper towel with water to add moisture. Do not let them dry out.
5. Within a few days, you will see a root that is a few millimeters long emerge from your seeds. (This can take as many as 7 days.) Move them from the saucer and plant them about 5–10 mm deep (about 3X the diameter of the seed) in a small pot filled with your grow medium of choice.
6. You should see the plants emerge from the grow medium within a few days. Once a seed has sprouted, it needs adequate light (either artificial or sunshine) to keep growing.
